



LOSSA GIRLS GOLF PLAYING REGULATIONS 2016 - 2017

Classification: Girls

1. All RCGA golf rules will govern the play on Championship day. A jury of appeal will be available to deal with any problems.
2. The location of the Championship must be at least 5000 yards and a minimum par 70.
3. A coaches meeting will be held on the day of the Championship to determine any special playing rules due to the conditions on the day of the Championship.
4. A school is allowed to bring any number of female golfers. These golfers should be COMPETITIVE and not golfing for their first time at the Championship.
5. There will be an individual championship as well as a team championship.
6. The top three (3) individual scores will receive LOSSA medals. The top individual will receive a LOSSA banner.
7. The team championship will be determined by a school's three (3) top scores. The top three (3) schools will receive LOSSA medals. The top school will receive a LOSSA banner.
8. In the event of a tie, for the individual championship, retrogression scoring will be used. For the team score, retrogression scoring will be used for each of the team members whose score is counting.
9. Each group will have a teacher marshall who will record the scores of the players in their group. Only the marshall's card will be attested by all the members of the group. The marshall's card will be submitted to the scoring table.
10. LOSSA will send golfers to the OFSAA Golf Festival based on the OFSAA qualification requirements.
11. Coaching will not be permitted by anyone on the course.
12. No electronic devices are permitted on the course by competitors; including but not limited to, MP 3 players, cell phones and distance finders.
